SF2391 Misbranding of Certain Food Products

- Established new Iowa Code chapters 137E (meat products) & 137A (egg products)
 - ► Key definitions include:
 - Manufactured-protein food product (cultivated, insect-based, plant-based)
 - Identifying meat term
 - Qualifying term
 - ► Fabricated-egg product
 - ▶ Identifying egg term
 - Qualifying term



SF2391 Misbranding of Certain Food Products (misbranding & prohibitions)

A food product is considered misbranded as a meat product or egg product if the product:

- 1. is or contains a manufactured-protein product or fabricated-egg product;
- 2. is offered for sale or sold by a food processing plant; AND
- 3. the label contains an "identifying term" without a "qualifying term".

Prohibits a food processing plant from selling or offering for sale a misbranded meat or egg product.



SF2391 Misbranding of Certain Food Products (violations & penalties)


- Credible complaints will be investigated
 - A stop order may be issued
 - An embargo order may be issued
 - ► Food processing plants found in violation are subject to civil penalties
- ► The Department shall not suspend or revoke a food processing plant license for violations of 137E or 137A.



HF2426 Hotel Inspections

- Repealed the requirement for biennial inspections of hotels
- Requires inspections of hotels upon receiving a complaint






DIAL Inspection Responsibilities Increased




