<u>Iowa Code Chapter 137D</u> Home Bakeries are changed to Home Food Processing Establishments

<u>Iowa Code Chapter 137F</u> Cottage Food Exempt from regulations (includes requirements)

Iowa Code Chapter 137F Packaged TCS Food sold at a Farmers Market is exempt from licensing at the market (source still applies)



Home Food Processing Establishments (FPEs)

Creation of **HFPEs**

New program area inspected alongside all of our other program areas (retail, processing, hotels)

Home Bakery Licenses converted to HFPE licenses

Existing home bakeries notified via email of the law change.



Demonstration of Control

Operators must demonstrate control and a thorough understanding of food safety principles by:

Proof of attendance in an approved food safety course

Written records and procedures describing control over food safety hazards in their establishment (SOPs, templates, records)

Observations during the inspection
