





- Creates a food processing plant classification for farms or private residences storing and selling processed meat or poultry from animals raised by the licensee.
- ► Sets license fee at \$75





- Promotes expanding local foods in underserved communities
- Promotes increasing food processing capacity for local foods in Iowa
- Does not directly impact the Food Safety Bureau






- Contains many provisions
- Exempts Home Food Processing Establishments from obtaining a license from IDALS Meat & Poultry Inspection Bureau for certain activities. Consistent with the exemption for grocery stores and restaurants






Expands raw milk distribution beyond the raw milk dairy to farmers markets and grocery stores

# **SAFHER** System for Agriculture, Food, Health, E-INSPECTIONS AND REGISTRATION

- ► Iowa was selected as a pilot state for SAFHER and expected to implement in the spring of 2025
- ► In December 2024, FDA eliminated federal funding for SAFHER
- ► The project was more than 80% complete when funding was eliminated
- ► In January and February, the Association of Food and Drug Officials continued development with existing funds to get the system to 90% complete
- ► Iowa is currently pursuing implementation of SAFHER without federal support
